- † Students must score at or above the 85th national percentile on the High School Placement Test to be eligible for this award.
- † One student with the highest score from each of the Catholic feeder schools\* will receive an award of \$400 provided that the student does not score among the top eight scores on the HSPT. (The student must be at or above the 85th percentile.)
- † If the top scoring student from a given feeder school\* does not register at SCC, the next highest scoring student is NOT eligible for the award.
- † This award is given to incoming eighth and ninth graders.
- † In the case of a tie at any position, the dollar amounts will be added together and divided among the number of students involved in the tie.
